

## COMMERICAL OFFICE BED BUG TREATMENT PROTOCOL

## AREA PREPARATION

- 1. Initial Canine Inspection alerts will determine our designated area of service.
- 2. Limited or complete shutdown of HVAC System and Air Flow.
- 3. Removal of all clothing from treatment area. (Clothing should be cleaned and placed in dryer for 20 minutes at approximately 150 Fahrenheit.)

## **INITIAL TREATMENT**

- 1. Steam Treat all soft areas, i.e.: chairs, couches, cubicle walls, carpet edges, etc.
- 2. HEPA Vacuum, all areas within the treatment area.
- 3. Apply an insecticide treatment as follows:

Our technicians will apply pesticides in areas such as electrical outlets, convector units, wall voids, baseboards, cubicles, furniture, etc. All applications will be applied in a *crack and crevice* method. As preparation for our treatment, we request that all electrical/cable outlet covers are removed and access to desk/cubicle areas is provided. Boxes and personal items should be lifted off of floor, allowing access to perimeter areas.

Following completion of application, area should remain vacant for four to six (4-6) hours at which time area should be ventilated. Occupants can return to area, in 8-12 hours.

## FOLLOW UP TREATMENT

Approximately 21 days following initial treatment, above procedure will be repeated, utilization products containing longer residual effects.
